Through the "Open Schools Open Doors" agreement, City of North Las Vegas, Parks and Recreation Leisure Services - Safekey Before and After School Programs are offered to students in grades K-5 at 21 Clark County School District (CCSD) schools. The Safekey program offers a healthy environment where participants will engage in, but not limited to, indoor/outdoor individual and small group games, arts and crafts, the Apple Core reading program, diversity, 4-H activities and an afternoon snack. The program is designed to enhance your child's social growth and development.

Students may work on homework during the assigned homework time. Safekey cannot enforce the completion of homework or ensure that it is done correctly. Safekey is a recreation based program, we do not offer tutoring or homework help. This is to ensure that children are not misadvised on homework.

You must sign your child in and out daily. The person who is scheduled to pick up your child must be listed on the participation form and they must show proper identification.



Craig Ranch Regional Park has multiple open space features, a state-of-the-art Amphitheater, event plazas, a 65,000 square-foot skate park and parking lots that can be reserved and configured to fit the needs of your next event. CANCELLATION POLICY AND REFUNDS: Any changes to your reservation must be made to the Park Office no less than 14 days prior to the reservation date to receive any form of refund. A refund of 50 percent will be issued if event is cancelled in person or in writing at least 14 days prior to the reservation date (30 days prior required for open space rentals). Refunds will be made only when proper cancellation procedures are followed. Refunds may take up to 4-6 weeks to be processed. The City of North Las Vegas will issue a refund if the event is cancelled by our department for the full amount, less any costs directly incurred by the City. A \$25 fee will be assessed to the issuer for all checks returned to the department for insufficient funds.

JUMPER POLICY: Jumpers and bounce houses are welcome in designated areas with approval from park staff, as long as the reserving group obtains a park permit through the Park Office. Staff reserves the right to charge an add-on fee for more than one jumper at certain shelters. All companies providing jumpers and/or bounce houses must have comprehensive liability insurance with the City named as an additional insured. Companies may not use stakes to secure the jumper and/or bounce house.

PERSONAL BARBECUE GRILLS: For the safety of our patrons, personal barbeque grills are not permitted in Craig Ranch Regional Park without written approval from the park supervisor.

COMMUNITY GARDEN: The Community Garden offers 62, 5' x 13' personal gardening plots that are available for reservations on an annual basis. Applications for the Community Garden are available online or in person at the Craig Ranch Park Office. The annual fee is \$150 per plot and includes water usage.

FARMERS MARKET: On the Ranch Farmers and Artisan Market is open every Sunday (rain, shine and holidays) inside Craig Ranch Regional Park. Summer hours are 8 a.m.-1 p.m. through September. Fall hours are 9 a.m.-2 p.m. Get farm fresh organic and conventionally grown produce and honey, along with locally made spices, sauces, oils, vinegars, kettle corn and Hawaiian shaved ice. Browse handmade jewelry, crafts, natural skincare products, clothing, incense and oils and children's books. Vendors also offer Reiki sessions and hot foods. Don't stop for coffee or tea because we have our very own veteran-owned café onsite! The market accepts cash, credit, SNAP/EBT, and Senior Nutrition coupons.
